This year the topics will be more focused and concentrating on subjects in which the development has been particularly rapid or interesting during the last couple of years.

# 4<sup>th</sup> Scandinavian Postgraduate Course in Paediatric Neuroradiology

A good radiologist is someone with good clinical understanding of the disease process. We will therefore address the topics of paediatric neuroradiology from the clinical perspective as we meet our patients every day.

The faculty includes some of the world's most renowned clinicians with expertise in the areas of neonatology, paediatric neurology and paediatric neurosurgery. The clinicians will provide the clinical background against which the imaging will be discussed by some of the most experienced paediatric neuroradiologists in the world.

All teachers will be present during the entire course and act as discussants together with the course attendees inside as well as outside the lecture hall. The language of the course is English. As the quality of existing literature in paediatric neuroradiology is excellent, there will be no syllabus presented. Each major lecture will be presented in a short abstract highlighting the most important points to be covered.

This course in paediatric neuroradiology is aimed at radiologists, paediatric radiologists and neuroradiologists in practise or in training and at paediatricians with an interest in neurology and neonatology.

### Venue

Ebeltoft is famous for its genuine market town atmosphere. Foremost among the many interesting buildings that line the cobbled streets is the old town hall - Denmark's, even the world's smallest. The town hall is open all year round, not just as a museum, but also as a registry office to which couples come from far and near. South of the town hall with the main streets of Overgade and Nedergade lie the houses which are generally thought of as constituting the old quarter of Ebeltoft. The very oldest buildings in Ebeltoft are, however, found far further north, i.e. in Nygade and Skindergade. But it is in the area south of the old town hall that you can see the crooked old timber-frame houses, which are so typical of Ebeltoft.
